Rare exhibit marks Black History Month 2018 in Toronto

“Celebrating Portia White ... 50 years on”, Feb. 3 to 28, is a Black History Month exhibit on the life and concert singing career of Canada’s first Black, international, classical star. It opens February 3 with a public reception, featuring acclaimed poet, George Elliott Clarke. Portia White is a federally designated person of historical significance.
